Players are put on a team of 6, ranked based on their skill level and are paired off against similarly skilled players. The number 1 player is the most advanced player on the team, while number 6 is the least advanced. The time of play is Monday, 7:00 – 9:00 pm. Four teams play each week. The other teams have a bye. The cost is \$5 per person.

- Each set will consist of the first team to 6 games, maximum 35 minutes.
- A first to 5 points tie-breaker will be played at 5 all
- All deuces will be sudden death
